that can be applied to the team will be a plus. 5. Other language skills will be a plus

(Japanese Students)

- 1. Have participated in SUSAP or Exchange Program, or have more than 1 month of study abroad experience
- 2. Have no problems communicating in English

(International Students)

- 1. Applicants must be able to communicate in Japanese or be willing to learn Japanese.
- 2. Have no problem communicating in English.
